

# 'A1' Report

A new look A1's team represented the Cheltenham Rustlers Baseball Club in the 2016 DBA season with a new head coach and a massive overhaul of our playing list. We added Ryan Morris from the Sandringham Baseball Club in his first full season of winter baseball and he didn't disappoint the Rustler faithful hitting over .400 and filling the hole at short stop with the loss of George Calill for a good portion of the season. He's maturity is well beyond his years and he was an integral part of the team being so close to a repeat of the success of previous years. A great team mate to have around and let's hope we see him next season down at Farm Rd.

The season got off to a great start with a full list to choose from and the boys smacking the ball around from the outset and recording some quality wins with dominant pitching from our young throwers Max Barrett and Lucas Anderson.

A loss to Frankston in a close one had us 5-1 heading into uncertain territory with the loss of 3 young guns to America where they would be chasing their dreams of playing college and affiliated baseball. All 3 men (Sam Trend - Beacom, Mitch Holding and George Callil) are a massive part of what we are trying to achieve here at Cheltenham and losing these boys really knocked the wind out of our sails.

The ones used 18 players this year from the likes of Jack Ogilvie, Matty Stenhouse got his feet wet on the hill against Pakenham, Jack Enciondo was a welcome surprise after a first half season in the states at College, Dean Cooper who we welcomed back to the club after an extended hiatus overseas, Long time servant Michael Rizzi, Karl MacKay and the young kid on the block Ben Firenzi who I personally think will be the corner stone of Cheltenham's success in future years.

The players mentioned above filled holes in the side we needed and some guys were forced to play out of position but to everyone's credit played without any fuss in what was a rough time for the club as the ones descended into a bit of free fall with some substandard team efforts both on the field and in the box.

The boys lost 5 in a row as the tables were turned on us from results at the start of the season that's until we played Pakenham for a second time. 3 up 3 down to the start the game then it was our turn to bat. We proceeded to hit for the next hour scoring 16 runs in a complete demolition of the opposition with the top 4 guys getting 3 bats each to put the game out of reach. Final score 27 - 0 in a true master class on how to hit the baseball.

Finals hung in the balance as 2 of our stars were still overseas and 1 respected team mate Koji Camptelli returned from a love filled 6 week road trip with his girlfriend in Europe to face Dingley knowing we had to win. A gallant effort going down 7-6 to a hot Dingley team

who had us needing wins in our last 3 games to give ourselves a shot.

We took care of business at Mornington with an away 3 - 1 victory on the back of pitching gem from Max Barrett and a massive solo home run from Andrew Russell. Games could not be scored and stats could not be forwarded to me without the help of Peter Leslie, Robyn Hogben and Steve Camptelli all sharing the duties. A very big thank you to you all.

2017 will be fast approaching and I'm looking forward to getting us back to where we belong. At the top!






