CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Firstly, welcome to all the Club Members who have taken the time to attend this our Annual General Meeting.

The past year has been quiet but with two major projects completed:

The first was the Second Diamond Backnet which was constructed specifically so the Club could host the VPBL Championships last June, and has now ensured better and more use of the Second Diamond over the twelve months of the year.

Concern was stressed that with that facility we still fall short of being able to use the ground optimally during the winter period.

The second project, for which we thank the Lord above (and Moorabbin Council), was the Car Park. Although not far from completion, the bitumen surface with marked parking bays has assisted our overworked ground co-ordinators on the days where large crowds attend our facilities. On completion, the Car Park will have lighting and reserved parks for selected members of our Committee.

With the list of the prioritized requirements from the Summer and Winter Committees now nearing completion, both Committees will be required to resubmit a weighted list of preferences of future requirements. Additionally, a request was lodged with Moorabbin City Council for drainage for Diamond No.2 as this Ground is unplayable for a large percentage of the winter months.

Finally, I thank the Members of the Board for their participation over the past twelve months, and thank the General Committee of Summer and Winter for their dedication in the particular areas of their responsibilities.
