Beyond that I would like to offer a big thank you's to all the planners and workers of our Horse Racing Night. A good time was had by all (except Ol' no split Matt McKenna.) Lastly in term of our social situation, we should of course highlight those Thursday Night meals which do such a great job of keeping people around after training. All credit for this obviously going to Katrina for continuing to go above and beyond.

'Preliminary Finalists'

This year the A grade had a very good season. We finished the home & away season in 3rd spot reaching the finals for the first time in 3 years.

Unfortunately a couple of these juniors who were playing some great baseball sustained season ending injuries shortly after the season commenced. Shelby Roberts (knee reco) and Blake Holding (elbow) hopefully both these players can bounce back for next season and make our side even stronger.

After dropping the first game of the season we pulled ourselves together and played some very good baseball for the majority of the season.

As what happens in most seasons these days injuries/holidays would give opportunities to other players. Matt McKenna, Jack Ogilvie, Tom Ogilvie, Rhys Fairweather, Yoshi Campitelli and Michael Hill had opportunities along the way with Jack and Yoshi cementing A grade spots. To the rest of the guys I thank you for always being willing to sit on the bench every game knowing that there wasn't always a guarantee of getting into the game.

Our pitching staff was outstanding all season. The start of the season was led by Jack Enciondo, Declan Croker and Brandon Stenhouse. After not playing summer Max Barrett worked his way back through the A2's but it wasn't long until he was back in the A1's. With these four pitchers I believe it's one of if not the best pitching staff in the comp. Stu, Jack O, and Josh Ashen also chipped in during the season. (seven pitchers in all who are pretty handy to have as a coach).

There was some big wins but we also had our fair share of tight games a disappointing losses. Every week our bats were alive hitting from 1-9 was a hugh strength. 'Premiers'

While we did drop off a little at the mid-point and stopped looking like the clear best team in the league, the returns down the stretch of the Russell Ferguson and Mack Turley, both of whom I think we are aware are a bit too good for this grade, really bolstered the lineup and was a key component in taking out the minor premiership and marching on to play off in the grand final for the second year in a row.

'U16' Report

The 2019 Cheltenham U16's season presented another opportunity for a group of young baseball players to put their skills to the test in one of the strongest leagues in Victoria. With an abundance of fresh faces around the club, Koji Campitelli, Jack Enciondo and I knew we had a great opening to take the u16's one step further than last year.

The season kicked off in traditional Winter baseball fashion with either a washout or a forfeit as we had secured 4 points before even taking the field. The U16's would endure many more bumps in the road including losing players to troublesome injuries or representative teams, which would wind up being the story of our year. Being relatively fresh out of junior baseball ourselves we understood the pride and excitement of representing the DBA and Victoria and wish to further extend our congratulations to those who were selected in these teams as they push forward in their young baseball careers.

The U16's season did not have a fairytale finish, the team finished with 6 wins, 3 losses and 3 draws. This however was enough to put us through to the finals where we faced off against Mornington who we had just played the week before. Unfortunately, we could not get to job done in a tight ballgame and were eliminated as a result. We felt that this game was beneficial to the players as it exposed them to some high-pressure game situations which you cannot replicate in the backyard or at training, a one run game in an elimination final is as close as it gets. This won't be the last high stakes game that the boys will face and the three of us were extremely proud of the way they handled the pressure. Throughout the season we played some of our best baseball against the top teams and it seemed that we were only ever one good rally away from winning these games. These types of performances are what solidify our spot as a powerhouse in the DBA.

The 2019 U16's was led by a self-appointed captain in Darcy Messenger whose enthusiasm for baseball is something hard to come by. Positioned behind the plate in arguably the toughest spot on the field Darcy was reliable and demonstrated leadership beyond his years. The one person who could keep Darcy in check was Blake Dunkley who returned for his second season with the u16's and was again stuck with us as coaches. The boys were always supportive and talkative on the bench, which is an important factor in junior baseball, not to mention their talent on the field keeping us in games or proving the difference in some games.

As those of you who have coached will know, each year is generally a different group of players and therefore it is difficult to gel the team together before the first game. However, this year's u16 did an excellent job of opening up and engaging with each other each session and as a result it created great team chemistry both on and off the field. Dylan Hind was our rally spark throughout

the year, our leadoff man and a real burner on the base paths. Dylan's witty personality was a great asset to the team and was key in our finals push and responsible for a lot of laughs throughout the year. Adding to that was Lachie Stevens, our all year round cleanup hitter was a real presence at the plate for us and a great defender, his tendency to swing at balls above his head actually produced a lot of hits, however when he got a ball in the zone he punished it, usually to or over the fence. Ryan Langworthy was another big bat in our lineup, and when he was available to play, he was often a huge contributor in the field, on the mound or with the bat. Ryan showed a tremendous amount of pride in wearing the Chelt uniform and was a great influence on the team.

Brent Dunkley, and Tina Haimona shared the scoring duties during the year and Koji, Jack and I cannot thank you enough for doing so, it is truly difficult to organize these things however you made it very easy on the three of us.

Finally, to the boys who have read this far. On behalf of Koji, Jack and myself it was an absolute pleasure to coach you all and we wish you all the best in wherever baseball and life takes you. Baseball is a wonderful sport and full of opportunities so I encourage you to continue along this path as you may find yourself one day living out your dream in the US or better yet in the seniors raising the flag alongside your best mates. Goodluck! We look forward to seeing your faces around the club.
