Members, Ladies and Gentlemen,

On behalf of the President and Committee we submit for your approval the 4th Annual Report and Balance Sheets for the year 1976.

Season 1976 was not as successful as we had hoped for and we are disappointed that premierships in our senior VBA and DBA sides did not come our way. Nevertheless premierships to our LBA-B Grade, C Grade and Under 17 teams were excellent results and our VBA-l side gave a creditable performance in the final series.

There was also a great deal of consulation to be gained from the continued improvement of our younger players. Cur Under 15 and Under 13 teams both finished in the finals and the season produced outstanding performances by individual players. The most notable being a 12-O shutout Grand Final win to Trevor Hogben in the Under 17's, a batting average of by Paul Kilburn from Under 15's and 6 home runs and a batting average by Neil LePage in the Under 13's.

Alan Tanner, our Club coach and Al Manager since the amalgamation in 1973 retired from the position at the end of this season and it is appropriate that we record our thanks and appreciation for his dedicated service. Under his leadership the VBA-1 team won 50 and drew 1 out of the 94 games in which he lead the club and the team appeared in 6 final games over the last four years. Managing is a thankless and exacting task when flags elude you and Alan is to be congratulated on a job well done.

The Social Committe continued to give excellent support and through their efforts we enjoyed a number of functions. The efforts of Nola and Alan Burdett, John Landry and Kew Hewitt in running the club rooms every week were outstanding and were the foundation of the clubs off the field successes this season. Cur hard working social group do not get the support they deserve and we appeal to you all to give them greater support next season.

The Junior Presentation Night was a notable success thanks to Graeme Ainscough, Frank Babidge (jnr.) and others who assisted.

The ground imporvements to Cheltenham Fark have eliminated a number of problems we had experienced in recent years and the assistance and co-operation we received from the Moorabbin City Council and in particular Cr. D. Blackburn was greatly appreciated. Future improvements of a relatively minor nature are all that are required to meet our needs with respect to the No 1 Cval and the Councils Flans for large scale improvements to the No 2 Cval during this current financial year will ensure that our Club has first class facilities for future seasons.

Special mention must also be made of the efforts and substantial contributions of materials by Lance Purton, Leo Anderson and Don Smythe which enabled the ground to be available for this season. Our thanks is also extended to Terry Anderson and Lance Purton for the pitching machine.

Finally our thanks to all those who assisted with our secretarial duties throughout the year, especially Jim Upfill whose successful co-ordination of 6 senior sides for the past four seasons is little short of amazing.
