LIFE MEMBERSHIP PROPOSAL - SAMUEL JAMIESON

Samuel Jamieson has been nominated for life membership of the Cheltenham Baseball Club Inc. for his outstanding service as a key administrator and as a player with over 400 senior games of winter baseball in all teams from VBA A Grade to DBA D Grade. Sam also coached senior teams on 4 occasions between 1979-1983.

Sam joined the Prahran B.C. in 1964 and at his peak was a very capable outfielder and strong hitter. He had played his way into the top level of Victorian Baseball in the late 1960's before moving to the Melbourne University B.C. Club briefly in 1971/72.

He returned to Cheltenham in 1973 and became the Treasurer of the Club in 1974 and has held executive positions with the Winter Section and/or the Board for the past 18 years. The positions Sam has held are detailed below.

The politics and variable qualities of office bearers in amateur clubs can cause many difficulties in establishing and sustaining a sound administrative framework and Sam's very professional and high quality commitments in this area have been a critical factor in ensuring that the Club has been developed and run on a sound financial basis.

He undertook much of the work required to incorporate the Club and made major contributions during the difficult summer/winter transition period and the many years that the Club struggled to find a permanent home.

Samuel Jamieson's nomination for life membership has been made by the Winter Committee and is endorsed by the Board of Management.
