B GRADE

In 1989 the B Grade consisted of twenty-six players, ranging in ability from D Grade players to ex A Grade players.

We welcomed a number of new faces to the club, Ryan Doray, Sean Hamilton, and Ian Rees (ex Bonbeach). However as per true Ruslter spirit, we were able to accept the new faces like they were our own and continue another successful season.

The beginning of the season was extremely unpredictable, the first six games consisted of four wins and two losses, leaving us third on the ladder. However amongst those games were a couple of outstanding performances from Sean Hamilton on the mound, and especially Matthew Stewart with the bat.

After the average start to the season the B Grade side began settling down and playing baseball the way a team with that much talent should play. Winning eight out of the next eight games. These eight games had three significant points to them:

- (1) This gained us top position on the ladder,
- (2) Put us back in top form, and,
- (3) Runs scored by us were 141, and against 46 !

As you can see outstanding statistics with only two games to go before the finals.

The last two games of the year were against Dandenong which we lost 7-17 (enough said of that game !) and finally ending up top of the ladder after a 13-9 win against Berwick.

During the year there were some exceptional efforts, from people like Darren Smith - SEVEN hits in one game and Gary Hicks pitching with results beyond himself. Steve Lewis entered into the team mid year with excellent baseball skills until an unlucky incident which broke his finger put him out for a number of weeks, however he still performed as a valuable team member. As well as Michael Ducksbury, Al Baker and Chris Reece - usually consistent match winning performances.

Then you come to a couple guys like David Johnson ,still a yougen', and Ian Rees. David had an outstanding year playing short-stop to a very high standard and pitching when necessary, winning many games.

In the batting box David really hit well, especially towards the end of the season, which I'm sure was evident when he hit a three base, three run shot to right field in the grand final ! Ian Rees a great team man and a wonderful catcher also had a great season for the team.

Then we had Mr. Paul Kilburn (Esq.) a man who gets more stirring than Uncle Toby's Porridge ? However I must admit that he definitely gives out his fair share. Paul again had a tremendous year and had a big part with Gary Hicks, who entered our side as a pitcher, were two of the main reasons we were as successful as we were.

Both finals were played against Berwick (against their will I'm sure). The semi-final, after a superb pitching exhibition by Gary Hicks, was a 4-0 win, with Cheltenham into another Grand Final.

This was the first time for quite a while that we had got in the Grand Final the 'easy' way (if there is a easy way). The Grand Final was played under difficult weather conditions, however the wind was blowing our way the entire game, with an end result of 7-2.

In conclusion I would like to congratulate all twenty-six players for a great year, and all I can say is that with the attitude displayed and the ability shown proves that the end result was only a mere justification of the efforts this year.

C GRADE

This year the C1 has continued to prove a major force in this grade. After the fantastic effort by Mark Johnson to get this team into the Grand Final last year, the pressure was on from the start to again reach the expectations of the Rustlers committee. Last year, we did not have a consistent pitcher until about the third last game and were reliant on fill-ins like Matty Stewart and Al Baker from the seconds. So the foundations were laid last year by Mark and all that was needed was a little "topping up".

Through the 1989 season, 26 players played in the C1's. From this 26, there is a core of about 12 players who were the backbone of the side.

This year the side has been blessed with pitchers. The emergence of Peter Jacobs through last years final series and the return of Peter Innes from B grade meant that the workload was shared during the year. This meant that the pitchers were not burnt out during the season and were ready for the hard work around finals time.

The batting has again been led by the established players and the addition of Ross Ginns and Paul Roberts gave it further strength. Matthew Hope, Bruce Fitzgerald, Russell Ingram and Darren Hiddlestone have again been the mainstay of the batting order, and all have averages well over .400.

Our fielding has at times let us down in pressure situations, but generally has been consistent. Paul Roberts has done a great job, either at third base or behind the plate. The addition of Kyle Burton late in the season was just what was needed to get a consistent infield. Until five players had been tried without much success, although Mark Fillips did a good job before going overseas. Darren Hiddlestone was again consistent without pushing himself too hard (a few extra nights training would help ?).

The younger players have done a marvellous job for this team and the club. Glen Allen, Mark Lewis and Leigh McHarry have come up for either their first or second year in C grade and have had to accept that they have had a job to do, which they may not have liked. They have helped out the veterans and D grade when they were short, helped with the umpiring and supporting their teammates when sitting on the bench.

Unfortunately, because of the number of players available for selection in the finals, their appearances on the field mat not have been long periods, but they should be encouraged by the fact that they are young and have time on their side. Hard work on the training track will eventually reward them in the future.

In closing, I would like to thank each player for their contribution to making the C1 the best team in the competition and for making my job an enjoyable one.
