'A' Grade Report

Looking back over the 'A' Grade score book, we used a total of 25 players for the season and only managed to put the same side on the field two weeks in a row once.

Player availability was a major problem. Whether it was holidays, work or weddings, the regular team changes made consistent performances very difficult to achieve. The positive out of this was that so many young players got an opportunity at 'A' Grade level and hopefully realise with a bit of hard work they can become regulars in this side.

The side finished the year in sixth place with 8 wins, 8 losses and 1 draw. Offensively this year, the guys who played the majority of the games performed well. The team batting average was .324 with 14 homeruns. Defence and pitching was always going to be a problem with regular changes in the infield and our two main pitchers taking trips to America in the middle of the year, we had to find everyone and anyone who could throw strikes to have a go. Consequently we ended up with a rather high earned run average of 8.63 which places the hitters under lots of pressure to score runs each game.

Congratulations to Mika Tossavainen and Ian Nolan for their excellent seasons. Mika and Ian finished the year with the 4th and 5th highest batting averages in the league.

Congratulations also to Rowan Brasher who represented Australia at the world under 19 championships in July.

Special thankyou to Jill Ward-Bourton for her efforts scoring and providing the statistics throughout the season and to Michael Gourlay for filling in in Jill's absence.




