

Dandy hit the ball well and we were saved on several occasions by our right fielder Adam who took some great catches and a crucial double play in the 8th by Peter Burnett and Johnny Carlisle with the winning run at the plate.

The grand final was against the unexpected opponent of Mornington which made us fell a little more comfortable going into the match.

We started the game with Laurie Hall on the hill and no runs scored. Our first at bat saw lead off batter John Carlisle get a decisive 2 base hit through the cones and Daniel Williams following that up with a bomb off the first pitch he faced. By the end of the first dig and we had 5 runs and not much pressure.
