

CLUB COACH REPORT-2002 Winter Season



From that point on in the season we got back on the winning list but we also lost some quality players to representative teams and had to fight a little more for our wins. We had some reserve player's step up and get the job done; Richie Lander and Chris Hook. This was probably one of the more pleasing things for me this season as it showed we had a little bit of depth and we were successful with the changes that had to be made. This leaves the club in good steed for the future.

All in all it has been a very successful season for the 'Rustlers' with every player giving their best on each game day and allowing us to obtain a 16-2 win/loss record for the year. This record now leaves us in a good position only to take out yet another premiership in the club's history. In closing, I would like to thank Dave Stenhouse for his persistence in getting me to coach as I am pleased to have taken on the job and met some really good people!

'A RESERVES' REPORT D.B.A. PREMIERS 2002

My report for season 2002 is written three days after we won the GF. It would be easy to paint a pretty picture about the entire season now that we have the flag, but that would not be the real story. We started the season with six sixteen year old players, one eighteen year old, three in their twenties and two in their thirties. On paper, it looked like a perfect blend of youth and experience. Unfortunately, our pitching suffered a setback when Shaun Miller had a shoulder problem early in the year. Our catching looked a little shaky as well when Pat O'Neill decided to get a full nine innings in lower grades early in the year. That only leaves our hitting and fielding, which at times was brilliant and at other times was very ordinary. We had many games with less than two players getting any hits, but we still managed to score some runs and win enough games to keep in touch with the top two. One thing we did consistently is steal bases and put pressure on the opposing defense. I have never been part of a team that could steal second and third at will like this team did. Coming to the last six games we were in third spot, but not far from dropping to fifth. This is when it all started to look good. Our defense started to play much better, and we were getting some consistent hitting from all of our young guys. We still couldn't get much from our bigger hitters at this stage, but something told me that Mika and Christian were just getting ready for bigger things. The leadership shown by these two and lan was very helpful to me as I could concentrate on getting ready for pitching in finals.

We did enough the last six games to finish second and Frankston was home team in the first final. We went run for run with them until the fifth innings when we were down 5-4 and we had two outs. This is where the senior leaders of the team took over and carried us. Mika had two strikes and got a good outside pitch that he managed to lob into right field for a very important run. He did the same thing next time and again a very important hit with good two strike hitting.

Christian had been quiet for the whole season, and at times looked like he really was not enjoying himself at the plate. To his credit, he always kept his head up and encouraged the younger guys even when he was struggling. I said to Christian after the Grand Final that he just about won it for us by his performance in the first final. He hit two home runs and another that looked like it went over was called a double. He also smashed the young Frankston pitcher in a run down and this was all to help us winning the flag. In the GF, they hit Christian intentionally and also walked him twice intentionally when he was the go ahead run. That sort of thing can be very deflating for the team in the field, and that is what happened to Frankston. With one out in the ninth, none on and down 10-7, it looked pretty bad. But when I saw Colonel, Ian, Mika and Tips all out of the dugout ready to hit, I though you never know what can happen. After this we all know that seven runs were scored, and I don't want to single out anyone as it was truly a team effort and the win was definitely justified because not one player gave up or looked around for someone else to do the job.

They all got in and did what was required and the flag is on the wall partly for every player in uniform that day.

One final thing about the day is about one player that I never expected to be in uniform that day. It is a great statement about this club that someone can put aside personal differences from the past and offer to help out on the day. He showed up and coached a base every inning, he was very positive, but I didn't expect him to play until Ritchie pulled a hamstring. Mark stepped in and just happened to be the one who put the game away in the ninth with a clutch hit. He also finished the game off with a double play when the Frankston catcher pulled a hammie also.

It just shows that the club is more important than any personal issues or personal statistics. I hoped to teach the young guys a few things this year, and I guess that final lesson is the best one. I saw many players learn about the game and grow in confidence this season, and I saw one or two players who believe that they know enough already and don't really have the grasp of team concept yet. Baseball is more than just ability and skill. It is about sometimes doing a role for a team or a club, which might not be the superstar role or the match winner role, but doing what needs to be done to make the TEAM a success. I was very happy to do the role of reserves coach this year because almost all of the players in the side this year did the team things every week and the well deserved reward can be seen hanging over the bar for all to see in future years. Thanks to all the players for putting in and enjoying the game because that's what it's all about. Thanks to David Stenhouse and the committee for putting on another successful season and last but not least, thanks to Karen for scoring.


