### 1<sup>st</sup> Nine Year In Review

The 1999/2000 season for the Cheltenham Baseball Club saw us drop from Division 1 to Division 2 halfway through the year, mainly due to the loss of players such as Alex Porecca, Mark Lesnik and Rohan Brasher and to a shorter pre-season because of the onfield success of Winter. Although the team was competitive in Division 1, it was not until after the cut in November that we played our best baseball.

Our win/loss record in Division 2 was 10-4 which enabled us to finish second on the ladder, play in the finals and most importantly start in Division 1 next year. However the team relies on too few players for its' success. Only four players – Darren Smith, Simon Myles, Matt Gourlay and Ben Wenke hit above .300 and Greg Brown was the only one to show any consistency on the mound. It is up to the other senior players to increase their output and for the younger players in the Seconds and Thirds to take the next step for the Club to improve.

This year 23 players had game time in the 1<sup>st</sup> Nine. Of those 23, 6 had some game time in the 3rds which shows there was good movement between the top 3 teams and that people were given a chance to prove themselves at a higher level.

The highlights of the year are no doubt Greg Brown's 'Complete Game Shut Out' Vs Sandringham and Ben Wenke's 3 home runs (including Grand Slam) at Coburg. It was also pleasing to see Travis Blackley and Glenn Sanders at 16 and Dan Williams at 14 become regular members of the team.

The low lights of the season, was dropping to Division 2 and losing our 2 finals at the end of the year.

In closing I would like to thank Assistant Coach, Tony Dinnie, Simon Myles for his outstanding job on getting a young 2nds team into the Grand Final, Lance Blackley for his outstanding job with an even younger 3rds team (all U16) and John Carlile and the 4ths for playing like 20 year olds and another Grand Final. Hopefully we will have more success next year.

Thank you to Greg Brown for looking after the team in my absence and to Michael Gourlay for his professionalism in scoring and being Chairman of Selectors.
