

Vale Jimmy Scott

It is with much sadness that we record the passing of Jimmy Scott age 92, on April 25, 2016

Jimmy was a Life Member of the old Prahran Club and one of our greatest players. Jimmy was an outstanding right arm pitcher with a superb curve ball. He was the MVP of Major A, the top level of competition in 1948 when he struck out 109 batters and he pitched Prahran to its first A Grade Premiership in 1949.

The headline of the newspaper report in the Sporting Globe that covered the game read: #

Prahran's Pitcher Scott Swings Title Game

Jimmy Scott won for Prahran its first "A" Section baseball premiership (4-1). He pitched winning ball throughout and ended as fast as he started. He curbed strong batters, and out pitched champion Tom Proctor, his opponent.

Scotty played with the Club from 1947 through to 1960 and represented Victoria in the Claxton Shield on several occasions. He was the Captain in at least one of the series and he was selected in the All Australian Team in 1953. A true champion with a great love of the Game.
